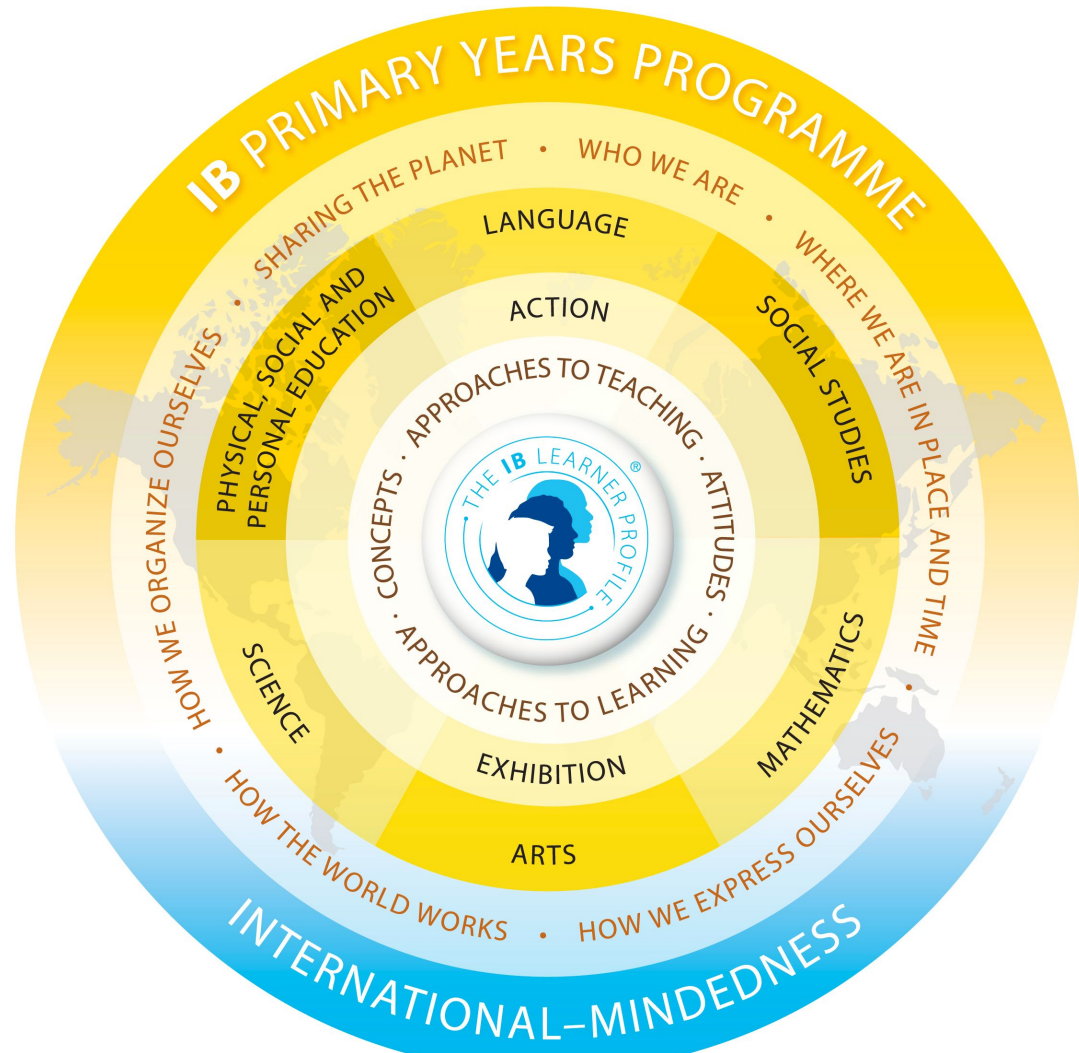

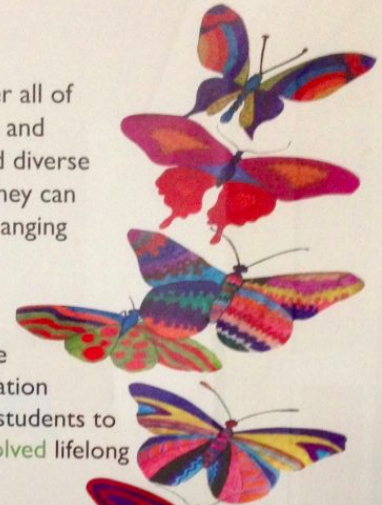


VIS Mission Statement

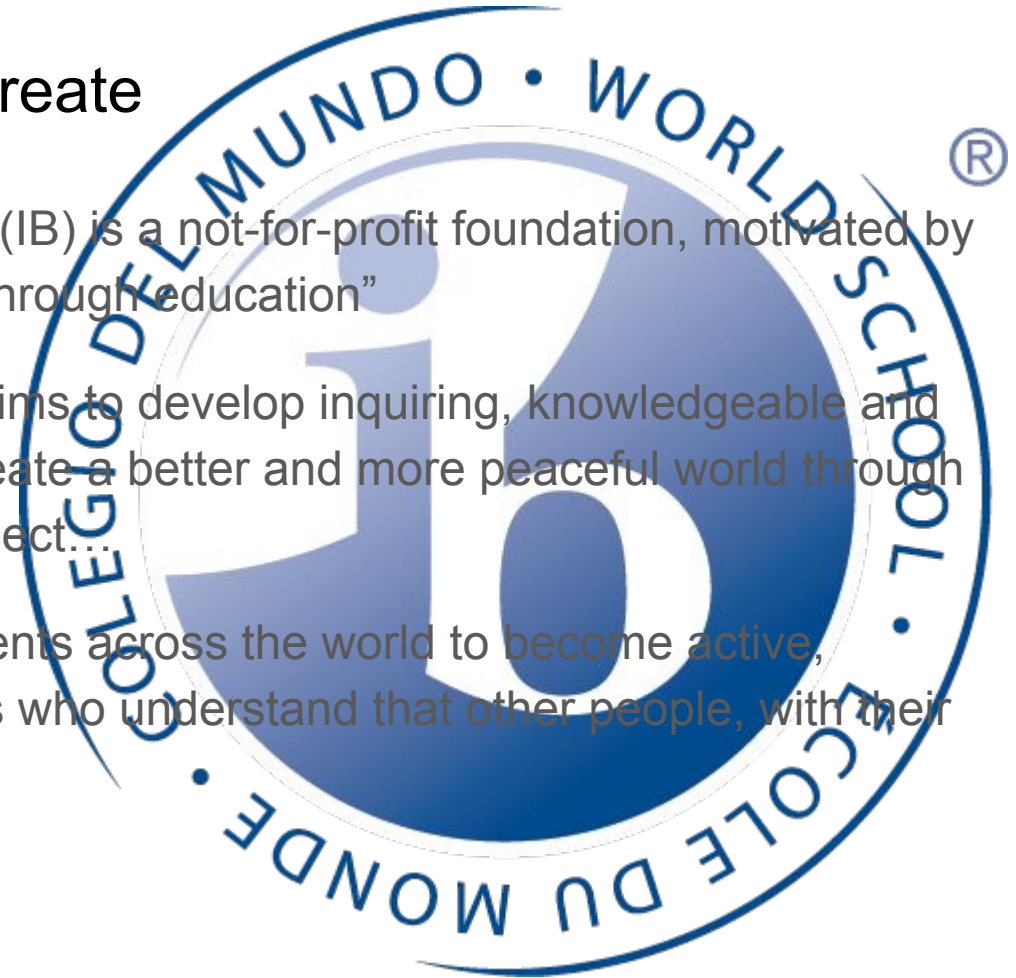

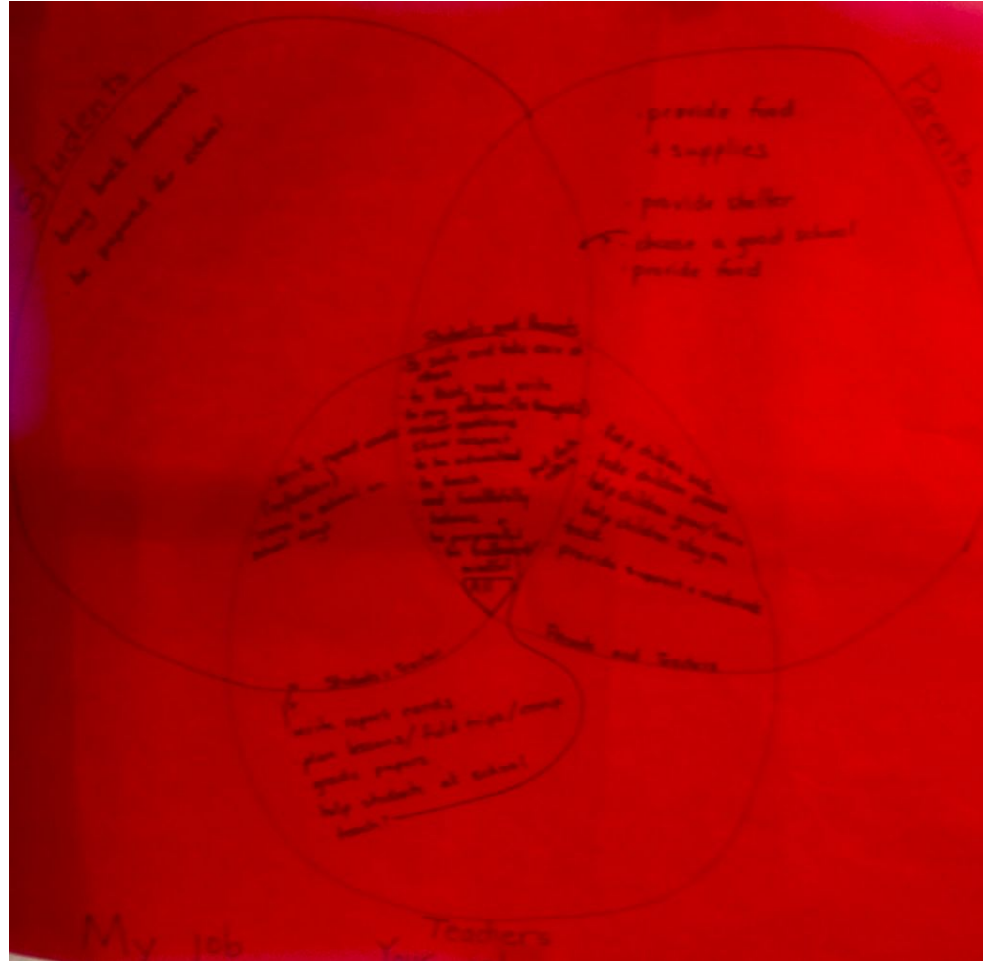
